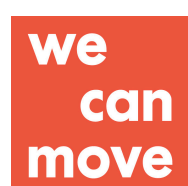

What is the award?

A process to help local community groups, clubs and activity providers to develop their inclusive practice so that they can welcome disabled children and young people. A great opportunity to gain public recognition for their commitment to inclusion.

Who can apply?

- Anyone who can demonstrate that they are providing inclusive opportunities where disabled and non-disabled children and young people can participate together.
- The award is aimed at provision for children and young people aged 0-25.
- Organisations based in Gloucestershire.

What is the process?



1 Meet Up

One of the team will meet up with you to explain the award and the areas of development that we focus on.

2 Submit Evidence

Use our award checklist and action plan to submit evidence. These are helpful tools to ensure that you cover all areas.

3 Hearing from Experts

We will ask to meet a disabled participant or invite a guest expert by experience for feedback and have a chat with them about their experiences.

4 Decision

We will combine your evidence and the participant feedback to make a decision on the award.

5 Support

Once the award is agreed we will continue to provide support, training and networking opportunities. We might also ask you to share your experiences of the award with new applicants.

The award support team will provide you with a range of useful resources, links, connections and network relationships to help you to continually develop and share practice with others.
